1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Unless it be otherwise expressly provided or there is something in
2 the subject or context repugnant to such construction, the following words,
3 phrases and clauses, namely: "present war," "present war emergency,"
4 "the existing state of war," "present defense emergency," when used or
5 named within this State in any manner whatsoever with relation to a pe-
6 riod of time shall mean so long as the United States of America continues
7 in the present wars with the Governments of Japan, Germany and Italy, or
8 any of them, and until the making of a treaty or treaties of peace concluding
9 all of said wars.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
