AN ACT concerning local registrars and deputy registrars of vital statistics,
and amending sections 26:8-13 and 26:8-17 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 26:8-13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 26:8-13. The term of office of a local registrar shall be three years and
3 he shall serve until his successor has been appointed and qualified. [If the
4 local registrar is the clerk of the local board, his term of office shall be
5 concurrent with his term of office as clerk, and he shall be subject to all the
6 rules and regulations of the State Registrar.]

1 2. Section 26:8-17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 26:8-17. The local registrar, immediately upon his acceptance as such,
3 shall appoint a deputy whose duty shall be to act in his stead in case of his
4 absence, [or] disability or death. In case of death of the local registrar
5 the deputy shall act as local registrar until a new local registrar has been
6 appointed and qualified. The deputy shall, in writing, accept such appoint-
7 ment.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to provide a uniform term of office for registrars and to grant authority for a deputy to act when the person who appointed him is deceased.
