AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to provide a uniform procedure for the enforcement of all laws relating to fish, game and birds, and for the recovery of penalties for violations thereof," approved March twenty-ninth, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section nine of the act to which this act is amendatory be and the
2 same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

3 9. Any party to any proceeding instituted under this act may appeal
4 from the judgment or sentence of the justice, district court, recorder or
5 police magistrate, to the court of common pleas of the county in which the
6 said proceedings take place; *provided*, that the party appealing shall, within
7 ten days after the date of the said judgment, serve a written notice of appeal
8 upon the opposite party, the opposite party to mean the complainant in the
9 case, pay the costs of such proceedings, and deliver to the justice, district
10 court, recorder, or police magistrate a bond to the opposite party in double
11 the amount of the judgment appealed from with at least one sufficient surety,
12 conditioned to prosecute the said appeal and to stand to and abide by such
13 further order or judgment as may hereafter be made against said party.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
