INTRODUCED APRIL 18, 1966

Referred to Committee on Business Affairs

AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages, supplementing chapter 1 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes and repealing chapter 264 of the laws of 1942.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. There shall be no discrimination in the sale of any nationally adver-
2 tised brand of alcoholic beverage other than malt alcoholic beverage, by im-
3 porters, blenders, distillers, rectifiers and wineries, to duly licensed whole-
4 salers of alcoholic beverages who are authorized by such importers, blenders,
5 distillers, rectifiers and wineries to sell such nationally advertised brand in
6 New Jersey.

1 2. In the event any such importer, blender, distiller, rectifier or winery
2 shall refuse to sell alcoholic beverages other than malt alcoholic beverages, to
3 any such individual wholesaler or comply with the provisions of this act,
4 then such wholesaler shall petition the director setting forth the facts and de-
5 manding a hearing thereon to determine whether or not said refusal to sell
6 was discriminatory.

1 3. If the director shall determine that said refusal to sell is discrimina-
2 tory and shall be satisfied with the ability of the wholesaler to pay for such
3 merchandise as ordered, he shall order the importer, blender, distiller, rec-
4 tifier or winery to complete said sale of alcoholic beverages other than malt
5 alcoholic beverages, to the wholesaler.

1 4. In the event said importer, blender, distiller, rectifier or winery re-
2 fuses to complete said sale or to comply with the terms of the director's
3 order, the director shall issue an order to every licensed wholesaler prohibit-
4 ing purchase by such wholesaler of any alcoholic beverages other than malt
5 alcoholic beverages, of said importer, blender, distiller, rectifier or winery
6 directly or indirectly until there is strict compliance by said importer, blender,
7 distiller, rectifier or winery with the order of the director.

1 5. The director shall adopt and promulgate such rules and regulations as
2 may be necessary to carry out and insure compliance with the provisions of
3 this act.

1 6. "An act concerning alcoholic beverages, and supplementing chapter
2 1 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes," approved June 25, 1942, is repealed.

1 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
