AN ACT to annex to the township of Millburn, in the county of Essex, a part of the township of Springfield, in the county of Union, and to change the boundaries between said counties to give effect thereto.

1 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 *Jersey:*

1 **1. All that part of the township of Springfield, in the county of Union,**
2 **and bounded as follows:**

3 **Beginning in the boundary line between the Counties of Essex and Union**
4 **and the Township of Springfield in the County of Union and the Township of**
5 **Millburn in the County of Essex, at a point therein where said boundary line**
6 **is the present southerly line of Millburn Avenue and the center line of a**
7 **brook which runs from the site formerly known as Wellington Campbell's Mill**
8 **Pond; thence (1) along said present boundary line, same being the present**
9 **southerly line of Millburn Avenue and across Morris Avenue, south 67 de-**
10 **grees, 32 minutes, 20 seconds west 1,588.83 feet to the present westerly line**
11 **of Morris Avenue; thence (2) along said present westerly line and along the**
12 **proposed new boundary line between said Counties and said Townships, south**
13 **52 degrees, 3 minutes, 10 seconds east 23 feet to an angle in said proposed**
14 **boundary line; thence (3) across Morris Avenue and along said proposed new**
15 **boundary line parallel to and 20 feet from said present boundary line, north**
16 **67 degrees, 32 minutes, 20 seconds east 1,577.57 feet to the present boundary**

17 line in said brook; thence (4) along said present boundary line, north 22 de-
 18 grees, 45 minutes west 20 feet to point of place of Beginning, which is situated
 19 in the Township of Springfield in the County of Union, is hereby set off from
 20 the Township of Springfield, in the County of Union, and annexed to, and
 21 made a part of, the Township of Millburn, in the County of Essex, and shall
 22 be governed by the laws of this State relating to Townships.

1 2. The boundary line between the county of Union and the county of
 2 Essex at this place be, and the same hereby is, made and established as
 3 courses 2, 3 and 4 of the description set forth in section 1 of this act so as to
 4 give effect hereto.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to annex to the township of Millburn in the county of Essex a strip of land 20 to 23 feet in width and approximately 1,575 feet in length which is located in the township of Springfield in the county of Union and to change the boundaries between the 2 counties accordingly. The strip of land is located adjacent to Millburn avenue in the township of Millburn, and county of Essex. Passage of the bill would permit the county of Essex, which owns and maintains Millburn avenue, to acquire the land annexed along with other lands presently located in the township of Millburn for highway purposes in connection with the widening and improvement of a portion of Millburn avenue. Such widening and improvement by the county of Essex is necessitated by existing traffic conditions on Millburn avenue. There are no residents in the strip of land proposed to be annexed. The proposed annexation and change in boundary lines has been approved by the townships of Springfield and Millburn and the counties of Union and Essex.
