A SUPPLEMENT to "An act to provide for and regulate the granting of sick leave to certain persons in the public schools of this State, and supplementing Title 18 of the Revised Statutes, and to repeal 'An act to provide for and regulate the granting of sick leave to certain teachers, principals, assistant superintendents and superintendents in the public schools of this State, and supplementing chapter 13 of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes,' approved May 6, 1942 (P. L. 1942, c. 142), as the title of said act was amended by chapter 237 of the laws of 1952," approved July 22, 1954 (P. L. 1954, c. 188).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Whenever any employee, included in the act of which this act is a
2 supplement, is absent from his post of duty as a result of a personal injury
3 caused by an accident arising out of and in the course of his employment,
4 his employer may pay to such employee up to the full salary or wages for
5 the period of such absence for up to 1 calendar year without having such
6 absence charged to the annual sick leave or the accumulated sick leave pro-
7 vided in section 1 of the act of which this act is a supplement. Salary or
8 wage payments provided in this section shall be made for absence during the
9 waiting period and during the period the employee received or was eligible
10 to receive a temporary disability benefit under chapter 15 of Title 34 of the

11 Revised Statutes. Any amount of salary or wages paid or payable to the
12 employee pursuant to this section shall be reduced by the amount of any
13 workmen's compensation award made for temporary disability.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the sick leave law applying to teachers and certain other employees of boards of education in the event of an injury arising out of and in the cause of employment. It provides that an employer may pay up to full salary for a period of absence caused by such on-the-job injury for up to 1 calendar year without having such leave charged to the annual sick leave or the accumulated sick leave of the employee. Any amount of salary payable to the employee pursuant to this supplement shall be reduced by the amount of any workmen's compensation award made for temporary disability.

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
