INTRODUCED MARCH 11, 1963

AN ACT providing immunity to members of volunteer fire companies providing emergency public first aid and rescue services or providing service for the control and extinguishment of fires from liability to respond in damages in certain cases.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. No member of a volunteer fire company, which provides emergency
2 public first aid and rescue services or service for the control and extinguish-
3 ment of fires, or both, shall be liable in any civil action to respond in damages
4 as a result of his acts of commission or omission arising out of and in the
5 course of his rendering in good faith any such services as such member but
6 such immunity from liability shall not extend to the operation of any motor
7 vehicle in connection with the rendering of any such services.

8 Nothing herein shall be deemed to grant any such immunity to any per-
9 son causing damage by his willful or wanton act of commission or omission.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
