AN ACT authorizing the destruction or removal of **[wild or passenger]** **certain domestic** pigeons in certain cases, and supplementing Title 26 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 23:4-53 of the Revised
2 Statutes or any other law, the State Department of Health **[and]** **or**
3 any local board of health within its jurisdiction may **[each]** order and pro-
4 vide for the destruction or removal of **[wild or passenger]** **escaped do-*
5 *mestic** pigeons **that have become feral** from any area or place upon a
6 finding by the department or the board, as the case may be, that the presence
7 of **[wild or passenger]** **such escaped domestic** pigeons in such area or
8 place is hazardous to the health of any of the inhabitants of this State.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

4 destruction or removal of wild or passenger pigeons from any area or place
5 upon a finding by the department or the board, as the case may be, that the
6 presence of wild or passenger pigeons in such area or place is hazardous to
7 the health of any of the inhabitants of this State.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Amend page 1, section 1, line 4, after "removal of" delete "wild or passenger", insert "escaped domestic"; after "pigeons" insert "that have become feral".

Amend page 1, section 1, line 6, after "presence of" delete "wild or passenger", insert "such escaped domestic".
