STATEMENT

33

34 This bill designates the portion of Interstate Highway Route 195
35 in the Township of Howell as the “State Trooper Marc K.
36 Castellano Memorial Highway” to honor the memory of State
37 Trooper Marc K. Castellano, who was tragically killed in a motor
38 vehicle accident while investigating an incident on Interstate
39 Highway Route 195 in Howell.

40 This State designation is to designate the portion of Interstate
41 Highway Route 195 in Howell in honor of State Trooper Castellano
42 without removing the federal designation from the entire length of
43 Interstate Highway Route 195. Consistent with Department of
44 Transportation policy and other road designations, the bill provides
45 that State or other public funds are not to be used for producing,
46 purchasing, or erecting signs bearing the designation for the “State
47 Trooper Marc K. Castellano Memorial Highway.” The
48 Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to receive financial

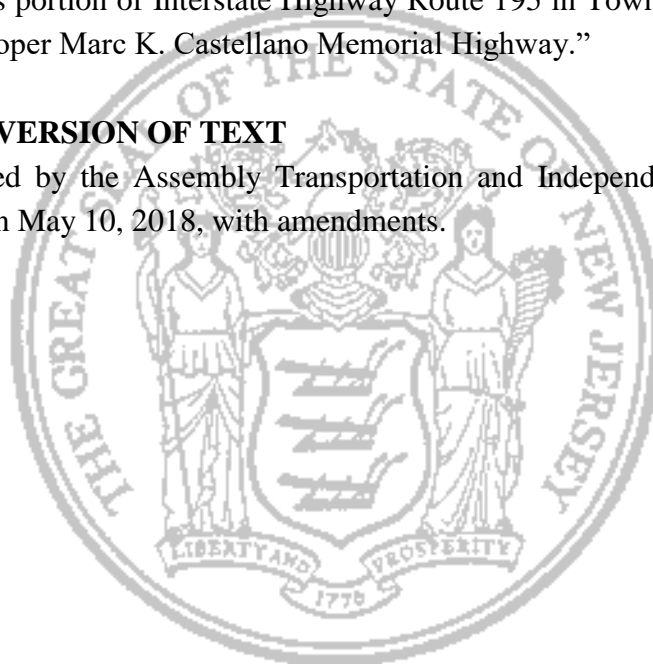

The Assembly Transportation and Independent Authorities Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 3749.

As amended and reported, this bill designates the portion of Interstate Highway Route 195 in the Township of Howell as the “State Trooper Marc K. Castellano Memorial Highway” to honor the memory of State Trooper Marc K. Castellano, who was tragically killed in a motor vehicle accident while investigating an incident on Interstate Highway Route 195 in Howell.

This State designation is to designate the portion of Interstate Highway Route 195 in Howell in honor of State Trooper Castellano without removing the federal designation from the entire length of Interstate Highway Route 195. The bill provides that State or other public funds are not to be used for producing, purchasing, or erecting signs bearing the designation for the “State Trooper Marc K. Castellano Memorial Highway.” The Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to receive financial assistance from private sources for the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining signs bearing the designation.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1. The Commissioner of Transportation shall designate the portion of Interstate Highway Route 195, extending from milepost 25.63 to milepost 32.21, in the Township of Howell as the “State Trooper Marc K. Castellano Memorial Highway” and erect appropriate signs bearing this designation and dedication.

2. State or other public funds shall not be used for producing, purchasing, or erecting signs bearing the designation established pursuant to section 1 of this act. The Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to receive gifts, grants, or other financial assistance from private sources for the purpose of funding or reimbursing the Department of Transportation

for the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining signs bearing the designation established pursuant to section 1 of this act and entering into agreements related thereto, with private sources, including but not limited to non-governmental non-profit, educational, or charitable entities or institutions. Work shall not proceed and funding shall not be accepted by the Department of Transportation until an agreement has been reached with a responsible party for paying the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining the signs.

3. This act shall take effect immediately.
