AN ACT to provide for the recording of maps, certificates, ordinances, proceedings or other documents for the vacation of alleys, streets, avenues, roads or highways in the offices of the register of deeds or county clerks of the various counties in this State in the book entitled "Vacations."

1 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1 1. Whenever by any act of the Legislature of the State of New Jersey, hereto-
2 fore or hereafter enacted, such act provides for the recording in the office of the
3 register of deeds or county clerk of any county in this State, of any map, certificate,
4 ordinance, proceeding or other document relating to the vacation of any alley,
5 street, avenue, road or highway in any municipality or county in this State in
6 any of the records of any such county clerk or register of deeds, the same shall be
7 recorded in the book entitled "Vacations," in lieu of any other book of record
8 designated in any of such acts.

1 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1 1. Whenever by any act of the Legislature of the State of New Jersey, hereto-
2 fore or hereafter enacted, such act provides for the recording in the office of the
3 register of deeds or county clerk of any county in this State, of any map, certificate,
4 ordinance, proceeding or other document relating to the vacation of any alley,
5 street, avenue, road or highway in any municipality or county in this State in
6 any of the records of any such county clerk or register of deeds, the same shall be
7 recorded in the book entitled "Vacations," in lieu of any other book of record
8 designated in any of such acts.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT.

By Chapter 142 of the Laws of 1922, page 250, the book, in which certificates of vacation proceedings or vacation ordinances are to be recorded, is entitled "Vacations"; and by chapter 169 of the Laws of 1926, page 278, and chapter 320 of the Laws of the same year, page 553, and by chapter 52 of the Laws of 1927, page 104, the recording of such certificates, ordinances or proceedings in a book entitled "Conveyances" is

provided for. The object of this bill is to provide one book or place for the recording of such certificates, ordinances or proceedings, and that being in the book provided by the first act mentioned, entitled "Vacations," as being more appropriate, and where vacations proceedings should be looked for instead of having them scattered through the deed books, as provided by the other acts.
