AN ACT concerning education and amending section 18:13-21 of the Revised
Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 18:13-21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 18:13-21. Whenever the commissioner deems it advisable, he may ap-
4 point a helping teacher to aid and direct the teachers in the schools of 2 or
5 more districts, but no appointment shall be effective until it is approved
6 by the State Board of Education. The commissioner, with the approval of
7 the State board, shall fix the salary of a helping teacher, and shall fix an
8 allowance for his traveling expenses, which allowance shall not exceed
9 **[\$500.00]** \$750.00 a year.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
