AN ACT concerning leave of absence and supplementing Title 18 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Any person employed by a public educational system or institution in
2 a position which requires a certificate issued by the State Board of Examiners
3 or employed in a professional educational capacity by a school, college, or
4 university which is either tax-supported or operated under contract with the
5 State Board of Education, who is a member of the board of chosen free-
6 holders of any county of this State shall be entitled to time off from his
7 duties as such employee, without pay, during the periods of his attendance
8 at regular or special meetings of the board and of any committee thereof
9 and at such other times as he shall be engaged in performing the necessary
10 functions and duties of his office as a member of the board.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
