AN ACT concerning the judges of certain county district courts, and supplementing chapter 6 of Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, each  
2 judge of a county district court, in any county having a population of not less  
3 than 400,000 nor more than 600,000 inhabitants, in office on the effective date  
4 of this act and who is not then required to devote his full time to his judicial  
5 duties, shall elect either to continue until the expiration of his term at the same  
6 salary as he shall be then receiving without being required to devote his entire  
7 time to his judicial duties, or to devote his entire time to his judicial duties,  
8 in which latter case he shall thereafter during the balance of his said term de-  
9 vote his entire time to his judicial duties and shall not engage in the practice  
10 of law and, thereupon, his annual salary shall be \$14,000.00, which salary  
11 shall be in lieu of any compensation prescribed or provided for by any other  
12 law. Any such election to devote his entire time to his judicial duties and  
13 to accept the said annual salary of \$14,000.00 shall be evidenced by a notice  
14 in writing to that effect, filed with the Administrative Director of the Courts  
15 and with the board of chosen freeholders of the county.

1 2. Each judge of a county district court in a county having not less than  
2 400,000 nor more than 600,000 inhabitants, hereafter appointed, shall devote

3 his entire time to his judicial duties and shall not while in office engage in  
4 the practice of law and the annual salary of each such judge shall be \$14,000.00.

1 2. In any county having a population of not less than 400,000 nor more  
2 than 600,000 inhabitants, each judge of a county district court in said county  
3 who is required to devote his full time to his judicial duties, may be as-  
4 signed by the assignment judge of the Superior Court of the county to hold  
5 temporarily the County Court of said county and, upon any such assignment,  
6 the judge of the county district court shall have all the power, authority and  
7 jurisdiction of a county judge of the County Court of said county.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
