

ASSEMBLY, No. 93*(Revised Statutes, section 45:6-10.)***STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 2, 1942

AN ACT concerning the practice of dentistry, and amending section 45:6-10 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 45:6-10 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 45:6-10. Every licensed dentist shall procure from the secretary-treas-
3 urer of the board on or before November first each year an annual certifi-
4 cate of registration. Such certificate shall be issued by the secretary-treas-
5 urer upon payment of a fee of [two dollars (\$2.00),] four dollars (\$4.00)
6 for those in active practice within the State or two dollars (\$2.00) for those
7 not practicing within the State. A nonactive registration certificate shall be
8 issued to those not practicing within the State and should a nonactive regis-
9 trant desire to practice during the registration year he may upon payment
10 of an additional two dollars (\$2.00) to the secretary-treasurer with the
11 return of the nonactive registration certificate for cancellation, be issued
12 an active certificate of registration. [and a] All active certificates so issued
13 shall be prima facie evidence of the right of the holder to practice dentis-
14 try in this State.

15 Every licensee holding an active registration certificate who may prac-
16 tice at any place other than that address for which his active registration

15 Every licensee holding an active registration certificate who may prac-
16 tice at any place other than that address for which his active registration

17 certificate is issued shall be required to obtain from the secretary-treas-
 18 urer for a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) a branch office registration certificate
 19 for each and every location wherein he practices; provided, that nothing
 20 herein contained, shall be construed to require an active licensee to obtain
 21 a branch office certificate for the purpose of serving on the staff of a hos-
 22 pital or institution which receives no fees (other than entrance registration
 23 fees) for the services rendered by the dentist and that the dentist receives
 24 no fees or compensation directly or indirectly for such services rendered; and
 25 further provided, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to require
 26 an active licensee to obtain a branch office certificate for the purpose of ren-
 27 dering necessary dental services for their patients confined to their homes,
 28 hospitals or institutions.

29 The secretary-treasurer of the board shall, on or before October first
 30 each year, mail to each licensed dentist, a printed blank form to be properly
 31 filled out and returned by such licensed person to said secretary-treasurer,
 32 together with the fee herein fixed for such annual registration. Upon re-
 33 ceipt of such form and fee, the annual certificate of registration shall be is-
 34 sued and transmitted. The board shall cause a notice to be inserted in not
 35 less than three newspapers, one in the city of Trenton, one in the city of
 36 Camden, and one in the city of Newark, to the effect that such annual reg-
 37 istration will be required. Such notice shall be printed in such papers, once
 38 a week for three consecutive weeks between September first and October
 39 first, each year. Any person who for at least twenty-five years shall have
 40 been licensed to practice dentistry in New Jersey and who desires to retire
 41 from the practice thereof, and during his retirement to refrain from prac-
 42 ticing dentistry, upon application to the secretary-treasurer of the board,
 43 may be registered annually, without the payment of any registration fee,
 44 as a retired dentist. The certificate of registration which shall be issued
 45 to a retired dentist shall state, among other things, that the holder has
 46 been licensed to practice dentistry in New Jersey but that during his retire-
 47 ment he shall not practice dentistry. The holder of a certificate of regis-

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48 tration as a retired dentist shall be entitled to resume the practice of den-
49 tistry at any time; *provided*, he first shall have obtained from the secre-
50 tary-treasurer an annual certificate of registration as hereinbefore provided.
51 The license of any person who fails to procure any annual certificate of reg-
52 istration, or in lieu thereof an annual certificate of registration as a retired
53 dentist, at the time and in the manner required by this section may be
54 suspended by the board in the manner provided by sections 45:6-7 to 45:6-9
55 of this Title. Any license so suspended shall be reinstated at any time
56 within three years from the date of such suspension upon the payment of
57 all past due annual registration fees and an additional reinstatement fee of
58 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). Any person whose license shall have been
59 suspended for such cause shall, during the period of such suspension, be
60 regarded as an unlicensed person and, in case he shall continue or engage
61 in the practice of dentistry during such period, shall be liable to the penal-
62 ties prescribed by section 45:6-13 of this Title for practicing dentistry with-
63 out a license. Any person to whom a certificate of registration as a retired
64 dentist shall have been issued who shall continue or engage in the practice
65 of dentistry without first having obtained a certificate of registration au-
66 thorizing him to resume the practice of dentistry, shall be liable to the pen-
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68 without a license.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
