AN ACT concerning the practice of dentistry, and supplementing chapter 6 of Title 45 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1 1. **\*[The State Board of Registration and Examination in Dentistry]\***  
2 **\*The New Jersey State Board of Dentistry\*** (hereinafter referred to as the  
3 board) may issue to qualified applicants limited teaching certificates author-  
4 izing the licensee to teach, demonstrate, and practice dentistry in all its  
5 branches, but only in and upon the premises designated in the license in which  
6 the science of dentistry in any of its branches is taught.

1 2. **\*[No such limited license shall be granted to any applicant who is not**  
2 **a citizen of the United States.]\*** The board shall prescribe the forms for any  
3 such application, and by rule shall determine the qualifications of the appli-  
4 cant to teach the science of dentistry as predicated upon the applicant's gen-  
5 eral and technical knowledge, similar to the qualifications required in this  
6 State for a license to practice dentistry without limitation. In all cases the  
7 applicant shall submit proof satisfactory to the board of his graduation from  
8 **\*a\*** dental school approved by the board.

9 No such limited license shall be deemed to authorize the licensee to  
10 engage in the private practice of dentistry either within or without the said  
11 premises.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

1 3. Every applicant for any such limited license shall pay to the board  
2 for the use of the State, the sum of \$10.00, and the limited license may be  
3 annually renewed on the payment of a fee in the sum of \$5.00.

1 4. No person shall teach the science of dentistry in any of its branches  
2 in this State unless he shall hold a regularly issued license to practice den-  
3 tistry in this State or a limited license under this act, and any violation of  
4 this provision shall be deemed to be an illegal practice of dentistry punish-  
5 able as provided in the chapter to which this act is a supplement.

1 5. Every educational institution where the science of dentistry is prac-  
2 ticed, demonstrated, or taught in any of its branches shall submit to the  
3 board from time to time a roster of all persons engaged in teaching any  
4 of the clinical subjects or who act as demonstrators or teachers in the lab-  
5 oratories or clinics where the practice of dentistry of any kind is performed  
6 on patients. The board shall prescribe a form for such roster and make rules  
7 governing their submission.

1 6. Nothing contained in this act shall be deemed to preclude a giving  
2 of lectures or the making of demonstrations in connection with the teaching  
3 of the science of dentistry by guest lecturers and guest clinicians who are  
4 licensed to practice dentistry outside of this State, and who are invited to so  
5 demonstrate or teach a specific technique or procedure.

1 7. This act shall take effect immediately but shall be inoperative during  
2 the 60-day period immediately following its effective date.

1 1. The State Board of Registration and Examination in Dentistry (here-  
2 inafter referred to as the board) may issue to qualified applicants limited  
3 teaching certificates authorizing the licensee to teach, demonstrate, and prac-  
4 tice dentistry in all its branches, but only in and upon the premises desig-  
5 nated in the license in which the science of dentistry in any of its branches is  
6 taught.

1 2. No such limited license shall be granted to any applicant who is not a  
2 citizen of the United States. The board shall prescribe the forms for any  
3 such application, and by rule shall determine the qualifications of the appli-  
4 cant to teach the science of dentistry as predicated upon the applicant's gen-  
5 eral and technical knowledge, similar to the qualifications required in this  
6 State for a license to practice dentistry without limitation. In all cases the  
7 applicant shall submit proof satisfactory to the board of his graduation from  
8 dental school approved by the board.

9 No such limited license shall be deemed to authorize the licensee to  
10 engage in the private practice of dentistry either within or without the said  
11 premises.

1 3. Every applicant for any such limited license shall pay to the board  
2 for the use of the State, the sum of \$10.00, and the limited license may be  
3 annually renewed on the payment of a fee in the sum of \$5.00.

1 4. No person shall teach the science of dentistry in any of its branches  
2 in this State unless he shall hold a regularly issued license to practice den-  
3 tistry in this State or a limited license under this act, and any violation of  
4 this provision shall be deemed to be an illegal practice of dentistry punish-  
5 able as provided in the chapter to which this act is a supplement.

1 5. Every educational institution where the science of dentistry is prac-  
2 ticed, demonstrated, or taught in any of its branches shall submit to the  
3 board from time to time a roster of all persons engaged in teaching any  
4 of the clinical subjects or who act as demonstrators or teachers in the lab-  
5 oratories or clinics where the practice of dentistry of any kind is performed  
6 on patients. The board shall prescribe a form for such roster and make rules  
7 governing their submission.

1 6. Nothing contained in this act shall be deemed to preclude a giving  
2 of lectures or the making of demonstrations in connection with the teaching  
3 of the science of dentistry by guest lecturers and guest clinicians who are  
4 licensed to practice dentistry outside of this State, and who are invited to so  
5 demonstrate or teach a specific technique or procedure.

1 7. This act shall take effect immediately but shall be inoperative during  
2 the 60-day period immediately following its effective date.
