PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Senator IMPERIALE

AN ACT concerning county assistance for the care of children afflicted with Cooley's anemia, and supplementing Title 9 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The board of chosen freeholders of a county which has no  
2 county home and hospital for children afflicted with Cooley's anemia  
3 may appropriate not more than \$5,000.00 each year for the  
4 necessary expense incident to the diagnosis and treatment for such  
5 children resident in the county under the age of 21 years, including  
6 the cost of surgical appliances, support and maintenance of such  
7 children, investigation of cases, and necessary traveling expenses  
8 incidental to the investigation and transportation of patients to a  
9 suitable home or hospital within the State supported by public  
10 funds or private charity; provided, however, that the board of  
11 chosen freeholders in a county of the first class having a popula-  
12 tion in excess of 800,000 may appropriate not more than \$10,000.00  
13 each year.

14 Before spending money for such purposes the board shall adopt  
15 such rules and regulations as it deems desirable concerning the  
16 requirements of residence and eligibility for such relief. Disburse-  
17 ments shall be made through officers designated by the board for  
18 that purpose on verified bills presented and approved as in the  
19 case of other county expenditures.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Senate Bill No. 281 authorizes the board of chosen freeholders of a county which does not have a county home and hospital for children afflicted with Cooley's anemia to appropriate certain annual sums for the necessary expenses incident to the diagnosis and treatment of said illness for children residing in the county. A county of the first class with a population of over 800,000 is hereby authorized to appropriate \$10,000.00 on an annual basis for such purposes. All other counties are authorized to appropriate no more than \$5,000.00.
