AN ACT to amend "An act concerning the adoption of children, their custody, control and rights of inheritance, and repealing subtitle 2 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes," approved July 23, 1953 (P. L. 1953, c. 264).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 14 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 14. Effect of adoption; relationships of parent and child; rights of in-
4 heritance.

5 A. The entry of a judgment of adoption shall terminate all relationships
6 between the child and his parents, and shall terminate all rights, duties, and
7 obligations of any person which are founded upon such relationships, includ-
8 ing rights of inheritance under the intestate laws of this State; provided, how-
9 ever, that when the adopting parent is a stepfather or stepmother, and the
10 adoption is consummated with the consent and approval of the mother or
11 father, respectively, such adoption shall not affect or terminate any relation-
12 ships between the child and such mother or father, *nor the rights of inherit-*
13 *ance under the intestate laws of this State through the other parent.*

14 B. The entry of a judgment of adoption shall establish the same relation-
15 ships, rights, duties and obligations between the child and the adopting
16 parent as if such child were born to such adopting parent in lawful wed-

17 lock. In applying the intestate laws of this State, an adopted child shall
18 have the same rights of inheritance as if born to the adopting parent in law-
19 ful wedlock. In the construction of any testamentary or other document ex-
20 ecuted subsequent to the effective date of this act, an adopted child shall be
21 deemed lawful issue of the adopting parent unless such document shall
22 otherwise provide.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
