AN ACT concerning motor vehicles and traffic regulations and amending section  
39:4-46 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 39:4-46 of the revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:  
2 39:4-46. Every vehicle used for commercial purposes on a street or  
3 highway shall have conspicuously displayed thereon, or on a name plate affixed  
4 thereto, the name of the owner, lessee or lessor of the vehicle and the name  
5 of the municipality in which the owner, lessee or lessor resides. The sign or  
6 name plate shall be in plain view and not less than 3 inches high. Where  
7 available space for lettering is limited, either by the design of the vehicle  
8 or by the presence of other legally specified identification markings, making  
9 a strict compliance herewith impractical, the size of the lettering required  
10 by this section shall be as close to 3 inches high as is possible, within the  
11 limited space area, provided the name is clearly visible and readily identifi-  
12 able. *In the case of a combination of 2 vehicles the requirements of this sec-*  
13 *tion will be served when either unit of the combination conforms with the*  
14 *above identification specifications.* No person shall operate or drive or cause  
15 or permit to be operated or driven on a road or highway a commercial  
16 vehicle which does not conform hereto.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
