INTRODUCED MARCH 24, 1930

AN ACT ceding to the United States of America jurisdiction in and over lands heretofore or hereafter acquired by it for military purposes in Monmouth county.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1 1. There is hereby transferred and ceded to the United States of America juris-  
2 diction in and over so much of the territory within this State as is included within  
3 all such lands as heretofore have been acquired by it for use by the Signal Corps  
4 of the Army, located about four miles northwest of Long Branch in the township of  
5 Eatontown, county of Monmouth, and known as the Fort Monmouth Military Reser-  
6 vation, and in and over all other lands that may hereafter be acquired by the United  
7 States of America for military purposes in the establishment, completion or extension  
8 of said reservation, but the jurisdiction hereby ceded shall continue no longer than  
9 the United States of America shall own said land or lands.

1 2. The said jurisdiction is transferred and ceded upon the express condition that  
2 the State of New Jersey shall retain concurrent jurisdiction with the United States  
3 in and over the said land or lands, so far as that all civil process in all cases, and  
4 such criminal or other process as may issue under the laws or authority of the State  
5 of New Jersey against any person or persons charged with crimes or misdemeanors  
6 committed within said State, may be executed therein in the same way and manner  
7 as if said consent had not been given or jurisdiction ceded, except so far as such  
8 process may affect the real or personal property of the United States.

1 3. The jurisdiction hereby ceded shall not vest until the United States shall have  
2 acquired the title to the said land or lands; and so long as said land or lands shall

3 remain the property of the United States, when acquired as aforesaid, and no longer,  
4 the same shall be and continue to be exonerated from all taxes, assessments and other  
5 charges which may be levied or imposed under the authority of the State.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
