STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED APRIL 24, 1967

By Senator RIDOLFI

(Without Reference)

AN ACT concerning crimes and supplementing Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any person who enters any building, structure or place used
2 for any educational purpose with the intent of committing therein
3 any indictable offense shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
