AN ACT respecting police and fire departments in municipalities in this State.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1 1. The governing body of every municipality in this State shall have the right,
2 when any policeman or fireman in any municipality is injured, or contracts any sick-
3 ness whatsoever as a result of and/or in line with his duties as such policeman or
4 fireman, to grant to said policeman or fireman full pay during the period that said
5 policeman or fireman is incapable of performing his proper duties and until such
6 time as he becomes physically fit for actual service.

1 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

ADOPTED MARCH 25, 1930

AN ACT authorizing municipalities, including counties, to grant leave of absence with pay to disabled employees, officers, servants or agents.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1 1. The governing body of every county or municipality shall have power and
2 authority to grant a leave of absence with pay, to any officer, employee, servant or
3 agent, who shall become injured or disabled, so as to be physically unfit for his
4 or her duty, as a result of, or arising from the respective employment duty of
5 any such officer, employee, servant or agent during the period of such disability
6 and physical unfitness for duty, where such injury or disability shall be evidenced
7 by the certificate of a physician designated by the governing body to examine such
8 person; *provided, however,* that no such leave of absence with pay shall exceed
9 one year commencing with the date of such injury or disability.

1 2. For the purpose of this act, the term officer, employee, servant or agent
2 shall be construed to mean any person employed by any municipality or county
3 receiving a fixed compensation.

1 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are
2 hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect immediately.
