AN ACT concerning the registration of certain motor vehicles in the State, and supplementing chapter three, Title 39, of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. No fee shall be charged for the registration of a motor vehicle owned
2 by any resident of the State of New Jersey who may qualify under the pro-
3 visions of Public Law 663—79th Congress of the United States of America
4 (August 8th, 1946); *provided*, this act shall apply only to one vehicle of pas-
5 senger type for each eligible individual and shall not apply to vehicles used
6 for hire.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this act is to provide free license plates to those veterans of World War No. 2, who, through the loss, or loss of use, of one or both legs at or above the ankle, have been provided with automobiles or other conveyances under laws administered by the Veterans Administration.
