An Act to amend "An act concerning the registration of certain motor vehicles in the State, and supplementing chapter three, Title 39, of the Revised Statutes," approved April twelfth, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight. (P. L. 1948, c. 28).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section one of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 1. No fee shall be charged for the registration, in any year or years, of  
4 one motor vehicle of passenger type, which is not to be used for hire, owned  
5 by any resident of the State of New Jersey;

6 (1) who is eligible for compensation pursuant to sections 38:18-1,  
7 38:18-2 and 38:18-3 of the Revised Statutes or,

8 (2) who has qualified or shall qualify under the provisions of Public  
9 Law 663—79th Congress of the United States of America (August 8th, 1946)  
10 or of Public Law 187—82nd Congress of the United States of America (Octo-  
11 ber 20th, 1951), and who is the holder of a current driver's license issued by  
12 this State, if such motor vehicle is equipped with such special attachments  
13 and devices as the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles in the Depart-  
14 ment of Law and Public Safety may deem necessary to provide for the safe  
15 operation thereof by such person.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
