AN ACT concerning the practice of dentistry, and amending section 45:6-13 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 45:6-13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-
2 lows:

3 45:6-13. No person shall practice dentistry within the meaning of this
4 chapter unless licensed so to do, and no person shall be deemed so licensed
5 unless he is now licensed and registered so to do or shall hereafter be
6 licensed and registered under the provisions of this chapter. No person
7 shall employ, for a stated salary or otherwise, or give aid or assist any person
8 not regularly licensed to practice dentistry to perform any dental operation
9 upon human beings in this State. Any person who violates any of the pro-
10 visions of this section or of any provision of this chapter shall be subject to
11 a penalty of \$300.00 for the first offense and of **[\$1,000.00]** \$2,000.00 for the
12 second and each subsequent offense unless otherwise specifically provided.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the penalties for violations of the Dental Practice Act.
