AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages, and supplementing chapter one of Title  
33 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. The holder of a plenary retail consumption license or a seasonal re-  
2 tail consumption license, after the effective date of this act, may sell and  
3 display for sale alcoholic beverages in original containers for consumption  
4 off the licensed premises only in the public barroom of the licensed prem-  
5 ises, such barroom being a room containing a public bar, counter or similar  
6 piece of equipment designed for and used to facilitate the sale and dispens-  
7 ing of alcoholic beverages by the glass or other open receptacle for con-  
8 sumption on the licensed premises; *provided, however,* that where, prior to  
9 the effective date of this act, alcoholic beverages in original containers for  
10 off-premises consumption were sold and displayed for sale by the holder of  
11 such license, either to the exclusion of sale for consumption on the licensed  
12 premises or upon a portion of the licensed premises other than the public  
13 barroom, such sale and display shall be permitted as heretofore and not-  
14 withstanding renewal or transfer of the license either from person to per-  
15 son or place to place, subject to rules and regulations to be promulgated  
16 by the commissioner.

1        2. Nothing in this act shall be deemed to limit the sale and display for sale  
2 of alcoholic beverages in original containers for consumption off the licensed  
3 premises to the public barroom on premises licensed under plenary retail  
4 consumption license or seasonal retail consumption license in any munici-  
5 pality in which the sale of alcoholic beverages by the glass or other open  
6 receptacle for consumption on the licensed premises is prohibited by law not-  
7 withstanding that, prior to such prohibition, such sale and display for sale  
8 was required to be limited to the public barroom.

1        3. Nothing in this act shall be deemed to prohibit the lawful sale and de-  
2 livery of alcoholic beverages in original containers by the holder of a plenary  
3 retail consumption license or seasonal retail consumption license issued for  
4 hotel premises to guests of the hotel in the regular course of business.

1        4. This act shall take effect immediately.
