INTRODUCED JANUARY 18, 1965

AN ACT to amend "An act concerning elections, and supplementing Title 19 of the Revised Statutes," approved March 31, 1945 (P. L. 1945, c. 68), to repeal sections 2 and 3 of said act, and supplementing Title 19 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 1. In counties having a population of 700,000 or more *inhabitants and in*
4 *counties having a population of not less than 300,000 or more than 400,000*
5 *inhabitants and in counties having a population of not less than 150,000 or*
6 *more than 200,000 inhabitants, [where voting machines are used,] each mu-*
7 *nicipal clerk shall, on or before the sixth day following the last day for*
8 *the filing of petitions for the primary election in each year, certify to the*
9 *county clerk the full and correct names and addresses of all candidates for*
10 *nomination for public and party office, and the name of the political party*
11 *of which such persons are candidates, together with their slogan and desig-*
12 *nation, and the order in which their names were drawn in accordance with*
13 *the provisions of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes.*

1 2. In counties having a population of 700,000 or more inhabitants and
2 in counties having a population of not less than 300,000 or more than 400,000

3 inhabitants and in counties having a population of not less than 150,000 or
4 more than 200,000 inhabitants, the county clerk shall cause to be printed a
5 sufficient number of official primary ballots and official primary sample
6 ballots of each political party, in proper form for the mailing of such
7 sample ballots at the times and in the manner and number as required by
8 the provisions of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes, and shall furnish such
9 official primary sample ballots to the proper officer or officers on the earliest
10 possible date preceding the primary election.

1 3. In counties having a population of 700,000 or more inhabitants and in
2 counties having a population of not less than 300,000 or more than 400,000
3 inhabitants and in counties having a population of not less than 150,000 or
4 more than 200,000 inhabitants, the cost of printing of the official primary
5 election ballots and primary election sample ballots shall be paid by the
6 county but the county shall be reimbursed by the municipalities, each munici-
7 pality paying such amount as shall be apportioned to it by the county clerk
8 based on the proportion of the number of such official primary election
9 ballots and primary election sample ballots required for use in such mu-
10 nicipality.

1 4. Sections 2 and 3 of "An act concerning elections, and supplementing
2 Title 19 of the Revised Statutes," approved March 31, 1945 (P. L. 1945, c. 68)
3 are repealed.

1 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
