AN ACT concerning motor vehicles, and amending section 39:4-46 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 39:4-46 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 39:4-46. Every vehicle used for commercial purposes on a street or high-
3 way shall have conspicuously displayed thereon, or on a name plate affixed
4 thereto, the name of the owner, *lessee or lessor* of the vehicle and the name
5 of the municipality in which the owner, *lessee or lessor* resides. The sign or
6 name plate shall be in plain view and not less than 3 inches high. *Where*
7 *available space for lettering is limited, either by the design of the vehicle or*
8 *by the presence of other legally specified identification markings, making a*
9 *strict compliance herewith impractical, the size of the lettering required by*
10 *this section shall be as close to 3 inches high as is possible, within the limited*
11 *space area, provided the name is clearly visible and readily identifiable.* No
12 person shall operate or drive or cause or permit to be operated or driven on
13 a road or highway a commercial vehicle which does not conform hereto.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
