AN ACT concerning elections, and amending section 19:23-17 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 19:23-17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-
2 lows:

3 19:23-17. Any person indorsed as a candidate for nomination for any
4 public office or [for member of the county committee,] party position whose
5 name is to be voted for on the primary ticket of any political party, may,
6 by indorsement on the petition of nomination in which he is indorsed, re-
7 quest that there be printed opposite his name on the primary ticket a desig-
8 nation, in not more than six words, as named by him in such petition, for
9 the purpose of indicating either any official act or policy to which he is
10 pledged or committed, or to distinguish him as belonging to a particular
11 faction or wing of his political party; provided, however, that no such des-
12 ignation or slogan shall include or refer to the name of any person or any
13 incorporated association of this State unless the written consent of such per-
14 son or incorporated association of this State has been filed with the peti-
15 tion of nomination of such candidate or group of candidates.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The purpose of this act is to make uniform the law concerning designations and slogans to be printed on primary election ballots.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey.

1 1. Section 19:23-17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-
2 lows:

3 19:23-17. Any person indorsed as a candidate for nomination for any
4 public office or party position whose name is to be voted for on the pri-
5 mary ticket of any political party, may, by indorsement on the petition of
6 nomination in which he is indorsed, request that there be printed opposite
7 his name on the primary ticket a designation, in not more than six words,
8 as named by him in such petition, for the purpose of indicating either any
9 official act or policy to which he is pledged or committed, or to distinguish
10 him as belonging to a particular faction or wing of his political party; *pro-*
11 *vided, however,* that no such designation or slogan shall include or refer to
12 the name of any person or any incorporated association of this State unless
13 the written consent of such person or incorporated association of this State
14 has been filed with the petition of nomination of such candidate or group
15 of candidates.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
