AN ACT concerning the maintenance of certain voter registration information and supplementing chapter 31 of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

(1) the date of registration of the registrant;

(2) the date of birth of the registrant;

(3) the party affiliation of the registrant, if any; and

(4) when a registrant has voted or votes in a primary or general election. The information on each registrant shall be updated after every primary and general election and shall be readily accessible from the tape or equipment on which it is maintained.

If the commissioner of registration has maintained 23 **b.** . information in any form regarding a registrant's party affiliation 24 or when that registrant has voted in a primary or general election 25 which dates to the year 1987, the commissioner shall be 26 27 responsible for maintaining that information for a period of 10 years as part of the current voter information file of the 28 registrant if it is already on computer or magnetic tape or 29 30 electronic data processing equipment of any kind and for converting such information to such tape or equipment if the 31 32 information exists but is not on such tape or equipment, so that it 33 becomes part of the current voter information file of the 34 registrant.
