1 AN ACT concerning county fire marshalls and amending
2 N.J.S.40A:14-1.

4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the
5 State of New Jersey:

6 1. N.J.S.40A:14-1 is amended to read as follows:

7 40A:14-1. County fire marshal; appointment; salary

8 The board of chosen freeholders of any county, by resolution,
9 may create the office of county fire marshal and such assistant
10 fire marshalls as deemed necessary and appoint a person or
11 persons to hold such office for a term of [one year] three years
12 commencing January 15, except that the first appointee's term
13 of office shall terminate on January 15 following his
14 appointment. The board of chosen freeholders shall fix the
15 amount of the annual salary of the county fire marshal and the
16 assistant fire marshalls, if any.

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be
19 applicable only to appointments made after its effective date.
