BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a member of the Police and Firemen's Retirement System of New Jersey who is an officer in the office of the county sheriff in a county of the second class with a population of more than 470,000 and less than 475,000 according to the 1980 federal decennial census may purchase credit for up to one year of temporary service which resulted, without interruption, in permanent employment by agreeing to make contributions covering the service. A member who applies to purchase credit for the service shall pay the full cost attributable to the increased benefits to be derived from the purchased credit in accordance with the actuarial method used to determine the cost at the time of the purchase. A member shall not be liable for any costs associated with the financing of pension adjustment benefits and health care benefits for retirees when purchasing credit. A member may purchase service credit under this act by making payments to the retirement system either in a lump sum or in regular monthly installments pursuant to any formula, rule or regulation which the Division of Pensions may establish.

If a member elects to purchase credit for temporary service and retires prior to completing payment therefor, the member shall receive a pro rata credit for the service purchased prior to the date of retirement, but if the member elects at the time of retirement, the member may make an additional lump sum payment at that time as will be necessary to provide full credit.

2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire one year thereafter.
