The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports this bill without committee amendments.

The bill enlarges the time frame during which a Board of Education of a Special Services School District is to annually organize by specifying that the organization meeting may occur at anytime, except Sunday, during the first two weeks of July.

Current law requires that the annual organization meeting of the board occur on July 1. Some boards of education have difficulty mustering a quorum on July 1 when that date falls within a Fourth of July holiday weekend. This bill is intended to provide school boards with the flexibility required to insure that a quorum is present for their annual organization meeting.

During the committee meeting the Department of Education and the New Jersey School Boards Association indicated their support for the bill.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
