#### STATEMENT

3 This bill provides that whenever a commission is established by an act or joint resolution, if the commission has a time fixed to complete its duties, the time period shall not begin to run 5 until the appointment of a quorum of its members, unless 7 otherwise provided in the act or joint resolution. This bill is necessary because frequently a large portion of the time 9 available to a commission is used up by the time it takes to appoint all of the commission members. If the time period begins to to run from the appointment of a quorum of the 11 members, a commission would have the original time frame to undertake the task with which the commission has been charged. 13

The Senate State Government, Federal and Interstate Relations and Veterans' Affairs Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 377.

This bill provides that whenever a commission established by an act or joint resolution has a time fixed to complete its duties, the time period shall not begin to run until the appointment and qualification of a number of members sufficient to constitute a quorum, unless otherwise provided in the act or joint resolution.
