An Act requiring State departments, agencies and commissions to publish certain notices and supplementing Title 52 of the Revised Statutes.

The Assembly State Government Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 1991.

This bill requires all State departments, agencies and commissions which award federal or State grant funds to publish notice in the New Jersey Register or other appropriate publication regarding the availability of those funds. The notice would include infomation regarding eligibility, application procedures, amount of funds available and the purposes for which they are to be used.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The committee amended the bill to permit a department, agency or commission to meet its obligation under the bill by publishing the grant availability notice in its own publication in lieu of publication in the New Jersey Register.
