The Assembly Law, Public Safety, Defense and Corrections Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 906 with committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 906 amends R. S. 30:1–7 and section 8 of P. L. 1976, c. 98 (C. 30:1B–8) to change the names of the State's prisons and correctional facilities. The name changes authorized under the provisions of the bill eliminate all references to the municipalities in which the prisons and correctional facilities are located, substituting either regional locations, descriptive identities, or the names of noteworthy individuals.

The bill also supplements Title 30 of the Revised Statutes to specify that whenever the former name of a prison or correctional facility is mentioned in any law, rule, regulation, contract, document, judicial or administrative proceeding the reference shall be deemed to refer to the new name of the prison or correctional facility.

The committee amended the bill to clarify the restrictions imposed upon the naming of future correctional institutions or satellite facilities. As amended by the committee, no new institution or facility could include the name of any local governmental unit as part of its name, but could utilize a regional reference (i.e., north, south, east or west) or a descriptive geographical designation (i.e., riverfront, mountainview, bayside, etc.).

The committee also amended the provisions of the bill to include a reference to the "Developmental Center at Ancora" in R. S. 30:1–7. The establishment of a developmental center in Ancora was recently authorized with the enactment of P. L. 1987, c. 32.

Assembly Bill No. 906 was pre-filed for introduction in the 1986 session pending technical review. As reported with amendments, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been **performed**.

The Senate Institutions, Health and Welfare Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 906 OCR.

This bill amends R. S. 30:1-7 and section 8 of P. L. 1976, c. 98 (C. 30:1B-8) to change the names of the State's prisons and correctional facilities. The name changes authorized under the provisions of the bill eliminate all references to the municipalities in which the prisons and correctional facilities are located, substituting either regional locations, descriptive identities, or the names of noteworthy ndividuals.

The bill also supplements Title 30 of the Revised Statutes to specify that whenever the former name of Trenton State, Rahway State or Leesburg State prison is mentioned in any law, rule, regulation, contract, document, judicial or administrative proceeding, the reference shall be deemed to refer to the new name of the prison. This bill also provides that a new correctional facility shall not include the name of any local governmental unit as part of its name.
