INTRODUCED MAY 12, 1986

By Assemblymen KELLY and ZANGARI

AN ACT concerning the Passaic Valley sewerage district and the
Passaic Valley sewerage commissioners, and amending R. S.
58:14-4.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 58:14-4 is amended to read as follows:

2 58:14-4. Each of the commissioners shall, before entering upon
3 the duties of his office, take and subscribe an oath that he will faith-
4 fully and impartially execute and perform the duties imposed upon
5 him by law, and shall cause the same to be filed in the office of the
6 Secretary of State.

7 The commissioners shall each receive for service under this
8 chapter an annual salary of **[\$6,500.00]** *\$10,000.00*, payable in equal
9 monthly installments, and they shall receive no other compensation
10 than that herein provided**];** provided, however, that each commis-
11 sioner appointed or reappointed to the board after the effective
12 date of this amendatory act shall receive an annual salary of
13 \$5,000.00, payable in equal monthly installments, and no other com-
14 pensation**].**

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill would increase the annual salary of the Passaic Valley sewerage commissioners from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00. This represents the first salary increase for the board of commissioners since 1953; in fact, the commissioners' salaries were actually reduced from \$6,500.00 to \$5,000.00 in 1975.

The Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission operates the fourth-largest secondary wastewater treatment facility in the country with an annual budget of \$45 million.

The Assembly Independent and Regional Authorities Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 2631.

As reported, this bill amends existing law to increase the annual salaries of the Passaic Valley sewerage commissioners to \$10,000.00. The board of commissioners has not received a salary increase since 1953 and the commissioners' salaries were actually reduced from \$6,500.00 to \$5,000.00 in 1975. This bill therefore increases the commissioners' annual salaries from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00.

The Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission operates the fourth largest secondary wastewater treatment facility in the country with an annual budget of \$45 million. The commission serves 30 communities in four different counties in northern New Jersey and handles an average of 300 to 330 million gallons of wastewater per day.

The Senate County and Municipal Government Committee reports without recommendation Assembly Bill No. 2631.

Assembly Bill No. 2631 amends R. S. 58:14-4 to increase the annual salaries of the Passaic Valley sewerage commissioners to \$10,000.00.

The board of commissioners has not received a salary increase since 1953 and the commissioners' salaries were actually reduced from \$6,500.00 to \$5,000.00 in 1975. This bill increases the commissioners' annual salaries from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00.

According to the sponsor, the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission operates the fourth largest secondary wastewater treatment facility in the country with an annual budget of \$45 million. The commission serves 30 communities in four different counties in northern New Jersey and handles an average of 300 to 300 million gallons of wastewater per day.
