- AN ACT to authorize the presentation of distinguished service medals to residents who served in the organized militia or in federal military service on active duty in time of war or emergency and amending N. J. S. 38A:15-2.
- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. N. J. S. 38A:15-2 is amended to read as follows:

38A:15-2. STATEMENT

This bill authorizes the presentation of distinguished service medals to residents who served in the New Jersey National Guard or in federal military service on active duty in time of war or emergency. At present, these medals are authorized only for Matter printed in italics thus is new matter. members of the National Guard. Many residents have rendered distinguished military service in the defense of their country in times of war or other military action. They have received no recognition from the State for this service. This bill makes such recognition possible.

The Assembly State Government Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 1835 OCR.

The Senate State Government Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 1835.

This bill authorizes the presentation of distinguished service medals to State residents who served in the New Jersey National Guard or in federal military service on active duty in time of war or emergency.

Under current law, these medals are authorized only for members of the State National Guard.

According to the sponsor's statement, the proposed change would enable residents who have rendered distinguished military service to receive recognition from the State for their service.

The committee amended the bill to place the amendatory language in a more appropriate location in the current law so as to avoid ambiguity and confusion.
