#### INTRODUCED DECEMBER 7, 1987

AN ACT concerning the taking of striped bass and amending P. L. 1987, c. 83.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1987, c. 83 (C. 23:5-45.1) is amended to 2 read as follows:

1. (New section) a. No person shall take from the marine waters
of the State in any one day, or sell, barter, offer for sale or barter
or have in his possession at any time, more than five striped bass
measuring not less than 31 inches in length, from the effective date
of this amendatory and supplementary act through July 31, 1987
and not less than 33 inches in length from August 1, 1987 through
September 30, 1988.

b. The possession of [more than one] any striped bass or parts
of a striped bass from which the head or tail has been removed
other than immediately prior to preparation or being served as
food, which is less than 31 inches in length from the effective date
of this amendatory and supplementary act through July 31, 1987
or less than 33 inches in length from August 1, 1987 through
September 30, 1988 shall be presumed to be possessed in violation
of this section.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

#### STATEMENT

This bill would amend P. L. 1987, c. 83 to clarify that the possession of any striped bass or parts of striped bass from which the EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law. Matter printed in italics thus is new matter. head or tail has been removed other than immediately prior to preparation or being served as food which is less than 33 inches is illegal. This change is required to comply with federal law.
