May 8, 1986

The Assembly Law, Public Safety, Defense and Corrections Committee favorably reports Senate Bill 1602 with amendments.

As amended, Senate Bill 1602 designates the third Sunday in May of each year as "Police, Firemen, and First Aid Recognition Day" and requires the Governor to issue a proclamation each year to that effect.

The committee amended the bill to include first aid, ambulance, and rescue services within the provisions of the bill so that Senate Bill 1602 would be identical to Assembly Bill 2183.

The Senate State Government Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 1602.

This bill designates the third Sunday in May of each year as "Police and Firemen's Recognition Day" in New Jersey. It provides that the Governor shall annually issue a proclamation and with the Legislature call upon all citizens and organizations to celebrate the day by appropriate observances.

The committee amended the bill to correct "part-paid" to read "part-time."
