ASSEMBLY EDUCATION COMMITTEE STATEMENT TO

Assembly Bill No. 143 DATED: January 27, 1986

The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports this bill.

This bill removes the two year residency requirement for members of regional or consolidated boards of education who change their place of residence from one constituent district to another.

At present an individual who changes residence from one constituent district to another constituent district within a single regional or consolidated school district would have to wait 2 years before being eligible to serve on the board of education. The bill does not remove the requirement that a member of a regional school board must reside in the constituent district which the member will represent.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1986 session pending technical review. As reported the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.

The Senate Education Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 143 with Senate committee amendments.

The bill originally reduced the residency requirement for members of regional boards of education who moved from one constituent district to another. The committee amended the bill to reduce the residency requirement to one year for all board members.
