An Acr to amend and supplement the "Library Network Law," approved January 17, 1984 (P. L. 1983, c. 486), amending N. J. S. 18A:74-2, and repealing N. J. S. 18A:74-4 and N. J. S. 18A:74-5.

- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 1 1. Section 2 of P. L. 1983, c. 486 (C. 18A:73-35b) is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 2. The Legislature finds and declares that promoting cooperation
- 4 among the various types of libraries in New Jersey will provide
- 5 this State's residents with full and equal access to library materials
- 6 and programs not currently available within their communities;
- 7 that increased cooperation and access will help control the cost of
- 8 maintaining local libraries, while providing for improved services;
- 9 that establishing a library network can best be accomplished by
- 10 assisting libraries to form cooperatives on a regional basis and by
- having the Division of the State Library, Archives and History promote, coordinate and fund such cooperative efforts and well as

On or before November 15 in each year, the State Librarian, 4 with the approval of the commissioner, shall estimate the amount 5 necessary to be appropriated to carry out the provisions of this 6 act for the succeeding fiscal year and shall determine for budget 7 purposes the amount estimated to be payable to each regional library cooperative or library with which the division contracts to × 9 provide cooperative service to the library network for that year and the amount necessary for supplemental library services pro-10 vided directly. 2 18A:74-2. For the purposes of this chapter, unless the context 3 clearly requires a different meaning:

"Annual expenditure for library services" shall mean the sum expended during the last completed fiscal year by a municipality or county for library services as certified by the governing body of the municipality or county to the commissioner, excluding any sum paid to the municipality or county under the provisions of this chapter.

["Area library" shall mean any library with which the state contracts for specialized services to all residents of an area specified in the contract.]

"Equalized valuation" shall mean the equalized valuation of the municipality as certified by the director of the state division of taxation for the year preceding that in which the calculation of State aid hereunder is made.

"Per capita" shall mean for each of the number of inhabitants of a municipality or county as shown by the latest federal census effective in this State; provided that upon application by a municipality or county to the commissioner, any special census of population taken by the United States census bureau subsequent to its latest effective census shall determine such number of inhabitants.
