STATEMENT

This bill provides that price signs posted by a retail motor fuel dealer on the dealer's premises and visible from any adjacent roadway shall include the price per gallon, or the price per gallon and per liter, for both cash and credit card purchases of motor fuel in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Director of the Division of Taxation. A retail motor fuel dealer who violates the provisions of this bill is also liable for a penalty of \$1,000 for each violation, which is in addition to the penalties currently provided pursuant to section 301 of P.L.1938, c.163 (C.56:6-3).

Current regulations recognize that retail motor fuel dealers are permitted in New Jersey to establish one price for the sale of motor fuel to their credit card customers and a separate lower price to cash customers, provided the discount approximates the economic value to the retailer of providing the discount to its cash customers.

The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 847 with committee amendments.

As amended, this bill provides that price signs posted by a retail motor fuel dealer on the dealer's premises and visible from any adjacent roadway shall include the price per gallon, or the price per gallon and per liter, for both cash and credit card purchases of motor fuel in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Director of the Division of Taxation.

Current regulations recognize that retail motor fuel dealers are permitted in New Jersey to establish one price for the sale of motor fuel to their credit card customers and a separate lower price to cash customers, provided the discount approximates the economic value to the retailer of providing the discount to its cash customers.

The committee amended the bill to remove an additional civil penalty of \$1,000 for any retail dealer who violates the provisions of the bill. Section 301 of P.L.1938, c.163 (C.56:6-3) already provides that a retail dealer who violates the signage requirements in chapter 6 of Title 56 shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$1,500 for a first offense and not more than \$3,000 for a second and any subsequent offense.



The Assembly Consumer Affairs Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 3862.

As amended, Assembly Bill No. 3862 provides that all price signs posted by a retail motor fuel dealer shall include the price per gallon, or the price per gallon and per liter, for both cash and credit card purchases of all types and grades of motor fuel.

Current regulations recognize that retail motor fuel dealers are permitted in New Jersey to establish one price for the sale of motor fuel to their credit card customers and a separate lower price to cash customers, provided the discount approximates the economic value to the retailer of providing the discount to its cash customers.

Section 301 of P.L.1938, c.163 (C.56:6-3) provides that a retail dealer who violates the signage requirements shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$1,500 for a first offense and not more than \$3,000 for a second and any subsequent offense.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

At the sponsor's request, the committee amended the bill to:

- Require that all price signs include the price for both cash and credit card purchases; and
- Specify that the retail dealer include on price signs the price of all types and grades of motor fuel sold.

with Assembly Floor AmendmentS (Proposed by Assemblyman PRIETO)

ADOPTED: DECEMBER 15, 2011

Assembly Bill No. 3862 (1R) requires signs to be posted by retail motor fuel dealers to indicate motor fuel prices for cash and credit customers.

These Assembly amendments would take out the requirement that the prices must be indicated for all types and grades of motor fuel and make other technical changes that would make this bill identical to Senate Bill No. 847 (1R).
