The Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2095.

The bill establishes professional sports team specialty license plates, and authorizes the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) to enter into licensing contracts or agreements with professional sports teams for the design and sale of these specialty license plates. Under the bill, the MVC may pursue agreements with professional teams and franchises including those with the National Hockey League; Major League Baseball Properties, Inc.; NASCAR; NFL Properties, LLC; and National Basketball Properties, Inc.

The bill specifies that the MVC is authorized to impose and collect a fee, in an amount to be determined by the chief administrator of the MVC, for the issuance of a sports team specialty license plate, and is authorized to impose and collect an additional fee, in an amount to be determined by the chief administrator of the MVC, for the annual renewal of a registration certificate of a motor vehicle that has been issued specialty license plates. Revenues derived from these fees, less any administrative costs incurred by the MVC, are required to be remitted to the State General Fund.

The bill directs the Chief Administrator of the MVC to notify eligible motorists of the opportunity to obtain professional sports team specialty license plates by notices included in registration renewal materials and postings in all MVC facilities and offices.

The bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2989.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Office of Legislative Services (OLS) is unable to quantify the fiscal impact of this bill due to the lack of information on the fees to be charged for the issuance of sports team specialty license plates and the annual renewal of a registration certificate of a motor vehicle that has been issued a specialty license plate. However, the OLS notes that depending on the fees imposed and collected for the issuance and renewal of the plates, the licensing or rights fees, if any, paid to the teams and franchises, and the number of plates sold, it is possible the State may realize a net increase in State General Fund revenues.
