This bill, as amended by the committee, would provide for the designation of baked goods and other food products prepared with "Jersey Fresh" produce as "Made With Jersey Fresh," and would encourage and support the purchase of such baked goods and other food products as part of the "Jersey Fresh" program.

The bill would encourage the purchase of "Made With Jersey Fresh" products (1) by the New Jersey Division of Purchase and Property, in the Department of the Treasury, and (2) at service areas along the Garden State Parkway, New Jersey Turnpike, and Atlantic City Expressway.

The committee amended the bill to add a provision directing the Secretary of Agriculture, in conjunction with the State Board of Agriculture, to develop and implement the inclusion of baked goods or other food products that are baked or made with "Jersey Fresh" products into the "Jersey Fresh" designation and program as "Made With Jersey Fresh" designated products.

As amended and reported by the committee, this bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2305 of 2010 as also reported by the committee.
