The Assembly Commerce, Tourism, Gaming and Military and Veterans' Affairs Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 3433.

As amended by the committee, this bill permits an individual with the rank of major general (2-star general) to serve as the assistant adjutant general for the Air National Guard.

Under current law, the Governor may appoint an assistant adjutant general for the New Jersey Air National Guard and the New Jersey Army National Guard. In either case, an individual with the rank of brigadier general (1-star general) may serve as an assistant adjutant general.

This change is needed to make New Jersey law consistent with policy directive 38-1 of the U.S. Air Force. This directive in part establishes organizational structures and manpower requirements. Based on the directive's manpower model, the assistant adjutant general position is now identified as a major general position.

The committee adopted a technical amendment to insert the word "assistant" before the phrase, "adjutant general for the New Jersey Army National Guard", to correct an inadvertent omission in the original bill.

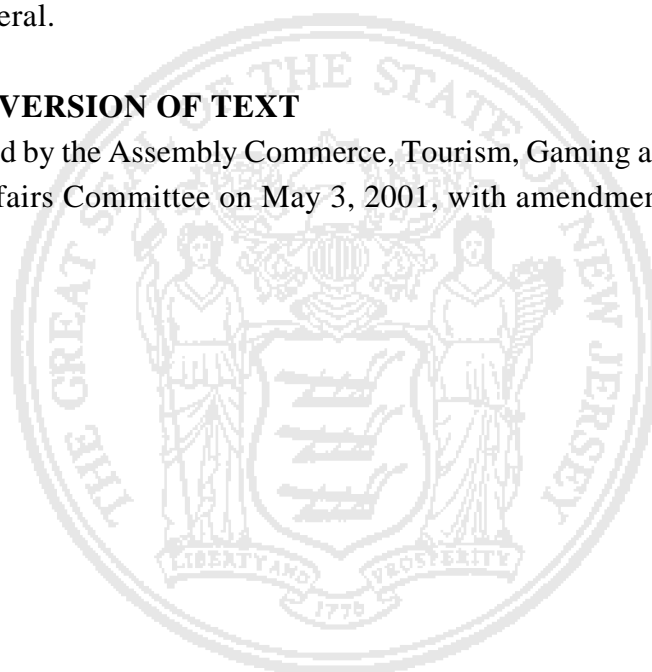

The Senate State Government Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2462.

Under current law, the Governor may appoint an individual with the rank of brigadier general (a 1-star general) as assistant adjutant general for the New Jersey Air National Guard and the New Jersey Army National Guard. This bill permits an individual with the rank of major general (a 2-star general) to serve as the assistant adjutant general for the New Jersey Air National Guard.

This change is needed to make New Jersey law consistent with policy directive 38-1 of the U.S. Air Force. This directive establishes organizational structures and manpower requirements. Based on the directive's manpower model, the assistant adjutant general position is now identified as a major general position.

## CHAPTER 317

**AN ACT** concerning the rank of an assistant adjutant general in the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs and amending P.L.1984, c.181.

**BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1. Section 8 of P.L.1984, c.181 (C.38A:3-5.1) is amended to read as follows:

C.38A:3-5.1 Assistant adjutant generals; rank.

8. The Governor may appoint, with the advice and consent of the Senate, an assistant adjutant general for the New Jersey Army National Guard, and an assistant adjutant general for the New Jersey Air National Guard, respectively, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. The assistant adjutant general for the New Jersey Air National Guard may have the rank of major general and the assistantadjutant general for the New Jersey Army National Guard may have the rank of brigadier general during the term of office and each shall serve on the staff of the Adjutant General.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
