# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED SEPTEMBER 12, 1985

AN ACT concerning the Passaic Valley sewerage district and supplementing chapter 14 of Title 58 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. The boundary lines of the sewerage district known as the 2 Passaic Valley sewerage district, created by P. L. 1902, c. 48, as 3 supplemented and continued by R. S. 58:14-1, are altered, amended 4 and extended to include that portion of the township of North 5 Caldwell as hereinafter described:

6 Beginning at a point on the common boundary line of the town-7 ships of Little Falls, Cedar Grove and North Caldwell in the vicinity of Coney road; thence running westerly along the boundary 8 line between the township of Little Falls and the township of North 9 10 Caldwell to the center of the Passaic river; thence running southwesterly along the boundary line of the township of Fairfield and 11 12the township of North Caldwell a distance of 449 feet to a point in the southern line of Fairfield road; thence running along the en-13 compassing Lots 8, 7 and 4 in Block 105 on the tax map of the 14 township of North Caldwell to a point where Lot 4, Block 105 15intersects Fairfield road; thence, southeasterly along Fairfield road 16a distance of 85.61 feet; thence running along and encompassing 17 Lot 3, Block 105 on the North Caldwell tax map to a point where 18it intersects Grandview avenue a distance approximately 175 feet 19 from the intersection of Grandview avenue and Fairfield road; 20thence running southwesterly along the center line of Grandview 21avenue and Grandview place to a point where Grandview place 2223intersects with the water transmission line of the Jersey City

Water Company; thence easterly along the water transmission line of the Jersey City Water Company to a point in the boundary line of the township of North Caldwell and the township of Cedar Grove; thence northeasterly along the boundary line of the township of North Caldwell and the township of Cedar Grove to the boundary line of the township of Little Falls and the point and place of beginning.

2. The boundary lines of the sewerage district known as the
Passaic Valley sewerage district, created by P. L. 1902, c. 48, as
supplemented and continued by R. S. 58:14-1, are altered, amended
and extended to include that portion of the township of Cedar
Grove as hereinafter described:

Beginning as the intersection of the boundary lines between the 6 borough of North Caldwell, the township of Little Falls, and the 7 township of Cedar Grove; thence running in a southwesterly di-8 9 rection along the boundary line between the borough of North Caldwell and the township of Cedar Grove to a turn in the bound-10ary direction; thence still along that boundary line running in a 11southeasterly direction to a corner; thence still running along that 1213boundary line in a southwesterly direction for a distance of approximately 1,000 feet; thence running in the township of Cedar 14 Grove in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 151,200 feet to the centerline of Pompton avenue (New Jersey State 16 Highway Route 46); thence running in a northwesterly direction 17along the centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 23 a 18distance of approximately 1,200 feet to the intersection of the 1920centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 23 and Lindsley 21road; thence running in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of Lindsley road to the boundary line of the township of Little 2223Falls; thence in a northwesterly direction along the boundary line between the township of Little Falls and the township of Cedar 24Grove to the point of beginning. 25

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

<u>S-2949</u>, sponsored by State Senator John A. Lynch, D-Middlesex, which raises fees charged by county clerks or deputy clerks of the Superior Court and registers of deeds and mortgages.

<u>S-2996</u>, sponsored by Senate President Carmen A. Orechio, D-Essex, which appropriates \$1,150,000 to the Department of Higher Education for Montclair State College to meet expenses associated with the termination of the Carrino Landfill, which is located on college property.

<u>S-3063</u>, sponsored by State Senator Matthew Feldman, D-Bergen, which permits the creation of community trusts for persons with severe chronic disabilities.

Community trusts allow the family members of persons with severe chronic disabilities to pool their resources to provide for care of the disabled family member when other family members are no longer able to do so.

<u>S-3315</u>, sponsored by State Senator Gerald Cardinale, R-Bergen, which redesignates the Glen Gardner Center for Geriatrics as the Senator Garrett W. Hagedorn Center for Geriatrics.

<u>S-3387</u>, sponsored by Senate President Carmen A. Orechio, D-Essex, which expands the boundary lines of the Passaic Valley Sewerage District to include a portion of the Township of North Caldwell and a portion of the Township of Cedar Grove.
