### INTRODUCED APRIL 30, 1984

An Acr concerning the Protestant Episcopal Church and amending R. S. 16:12-16.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. R. S. 16:12-16 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 16:12-16. If and when the convention of said church which has
- 3 ecclesiastical jurisdiction over a parish shall determine that regular
- 4 church services are no longer maintained by such parish, or that the
- 5 parish no longer elects wardens and a vestry in accordance iwth tts
- 6 certificate of incorporation, said convention may declare such
- 7 parish extinct, and thereupon the corporation having title to the
- 8 property of said parish shall be thereby dissolved and the property
- 9 of said parish and all rights and interest of said parish pertaining
- 10 to property shall vest in the corporation organized to hold in trust
- 11 property under the control of said convention, in trust, for the
- 12 same religious purposes and with the power of disposition and sale
- 13 to the same extent as the same vested or would have vested in the
- 14 corporation having title to the property of said parish before it
- 15 became extinct; provided, however, that this act shall not affect
- 16 the reversionary interest of any person or persons in such property.

- 18 thereof shall be applied to religious and charitable uses connected
- 19 with the church, and the convention may direct the use to which the

- 21 fer thereof or any part thereof to any incorporated parish or other
- 22 corporation, the funds of which are devoted to carrying on any of
- 23 the objects or purposes of said church in said diocese. If and when
- 24 the convention of said church shall make such determination and
- 25 declare a parish extinct, a certificate of such action by the con-
- 26 vention under the seal of the convention, signed by the bishop or
- 27 other officer who presided at the meeting of the convention at which
- 28 such action was taken and attested by the secretary of said con-
- 29 vention and duly acknowledged, shall be filed and recorded in the
- 30 office of the county clerk of the county where the certificate of in-
- 31 corporation of said parish has been filed, or where such extinct
- 32 parish is located.
