An Act concerning the rates of compensation of members of the North Jersey district water supply commission, and amending R. S. 58:5-4.

- 2 58:5-4. Each commissioner shall receive a salary at the rate of

- 5 cipality, which salary shall be accumulative and payable upon the
- 6 execution of any such contract, and thereafter each commissioner
- 7 shall receive a salary at the rate of [five thousand dollars]
- 8 \$7,500.00 per annum payable monthly, except the chairman of the
- 9 commission, chosen as hereinafter provided, who shall receive
- 10 a salary at the rate of [six thousand dollars] \$8,500.00 per annum.
- 11 Such salaries shall be charged as an expense of the development
- 12 and operation of any water supply contracted for hereunder.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Governor Thomas H. Kean has signed the following bills:

A-2493, sponsored by Assemblyman Joseph L. Bocchini, D-Mercer, which appropriates \$163,800 for the restoration of Lake Etra in East Windsor Township. The 18.5 acre lake is part of a township park. The funds will be used to help finance the draining and dredging of the lake to remove accumulated sediment and aquatic plant life.

5x-1386, sponsored by State Senator John H. Ewing, R-Somerset, which authorizes the State Registrar of Vital Statistics to issue an amended birth certificate upon the request of an individual who has undergone sex change surgery.

S-73, sponsored by State Senator Richard J. Codey, D-Essex, which increases the salaries of members of the North Jersey District Water Supply Commission from \$5,000 to \$7,500. The salary of the chairman of the Commission increased from \$6,000 to \$8,500. The increases are the first since 1929.
