AN ACT concerning *annual* school elections * [for 1983]* and supplementing Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

Notwithstanding the provision of any law to the contrary,
 for the 1982-1983 school year, the annual school election shall be
 held on * [March 22] * * A pril 12*, 1983.

1 2. The Commissioner of Education is authorized to make any 2 necessary adjustments to the school budget and election calendar 3 affected by section 1 of this act.

1 *3. In any school year after the 1982-83 school year the Com-

2 missioner of Education shall make any adjustments to the school

3 budget and election calendar which may be necessary to change

4 the annual school election date provided pursuant to law if that

5 date coincides with a period of religious observance. The commis-

6 sioner shall inform local school boards of these adjustments no later

7 than the first working day in January of the year in which the ad-

8 justments are to occur.*

1 ***[3.]* *4.*** This act shall take effect immediately.

DATED: NOVEMBER 29, 1982

PROVISIONS:

This bill as amended changes the date of the annual school election to April 12 and authorizes the Commissioner of Education to make what other adjustments are necessary in the school budget and election calendar to accommodate this change.

BACKGROUND:

This change is necessary since the school election now scheduled for April 5th is in conflict with the observance of Passover.

Committee Amendment:

Since the annual school election periodically conflicts with the observance of Passover and Easter, the committee has added a new section to Senate Bill No. 1799 authorizing the Commissioner of Education to make the necessary adjustments whenever this occurs, thus eliminating the need for special authorization each time this occurs.

Also, the committee felt that April 12 was preferable to March 22 as the date for the 1982-83 election.
