AN ACT concerning motor vehicle registration and amending R. S.  
39:3-27.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 39:3-27 is amended to read as follows:

2 39:3-27. No fee shall be charged for the registration of motor  
3 vehicles not used for pleasure or hire, owned by the United States,  
4 the State of New Jersey, a municipality, county, Regional Air  
5 Pollution Control Agency, Passaic Valley Sewerage Commissioners,  
6 North Jersey District Water Supply Commission, a county im-  
7 provement authority created under the "county improvement  
8 authorities law" (P. L. 1960, c. 183), a local school district, a  
9 regional school district, a county vocational or technical school, a  
10 duly authorized volunteer fire department, a duly authorized volun-  
11 teer first aid, rescue or emergency squad, any duly recognized  
12 auxiliary or reserve police organization of any municipality,  
13 hospital, humane society, and anticruelty society in this State, New  
14 Jersey wing of the Civil Air Patrol incorporated by the Act of  
15 July 1946 (Public Law 476-79th Congress), the American Red  
16 Cross, chartered local councils in New Jersey of the Boy Scouts  
17 of America or the Girl Scouts of the United States of America,  
18 *chartered local councils in New Jersey of the Boys Clubs of America*  
19 *or the Girls Clubs of America\**, *chartered local organizations of*  
19A *the Police Athletic League\** or ambulances owned by nationally

20 organized recognized veterans' organizations. These vehicles shall  
21 be registered and display number plates as provided in this sub-  
22 title or the director may, in his discretion, issue special registration  
23 certificates and special number plates for any of these motor  
24 vehicles which shall be valid for such motor vehicle until the trans-  
25 fer of ownership or the destruction of such motor vehicles at which  
26 time the special registration shall expire. Upon the expiration of  
27 any special registration the registration certificate and special  
28 number marker shall be returned to the director; provided, how-  
29 ever, upon proper application to the director the special registra-  
30 tion and special number marker may be transferred to another  
31 motor vehicle acquired by the owner to whom the special registra-  
32 tion and marker were issued.

The purpose of this bill is to exempt from registration fees motor vehicles not used for pleasure or hire and owned by chartered local councils in New Jersey of the Boys' Clubs of America and the Girls' Clubs of America.

Current law exempts from registration fees motor vehicles owned by similar organizations, such as the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl Scouts of America.

Governor Thomas H. Kean has signed the following bills:

A-564, sponsored by Assemblyman Joseph V. Doria, Jr., D-Hudson, which makes a simple assault on any school board member or employee an aggravated assault.

A-284, sponsored by Assemblyman S. M. Terry LaCorte, R-Passaic, which exempts from paying motor vehicle registration fees chartered local councils of the Boys Clubs of America, the Girls Clubs of America and the Police Athletic League.

A-1684, sponsored by Assemblyman Harry A. McEnroe, D-Essex, which appropriates \$20 million from the Energy Conservation Bond Act of 1980.

A-1601, sponsored by Assemblywoman Angela D. Perun, D-Middlesex, which prohibits the exhibition of animals in shopping malls, with certain exceptions.

A-894, sponsored by Assemblyman Byron M. Baer, D-Bergen, which requires the driver of a vehicle carrying radioactive materials to produce a certificate of handling when requested to do so by the State Police or the Department of Environmental Protection.

A-590, sponsored by Assemblyman Alan J. Karcher, (D-Middlesex), which permits hold-harmless clauses in construction contracts except in cases where the damages are due to the sole negligence of the person receiving the promise.

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
